Minutes Approval	• October 27, 2016
Presentations	 Jane Arntzen-Schumacher provided an update on Child Care Connections plan they have implemented to provide child care services for responders in an emergency. They have an agreement in place for a primary facility in Bozeman and have worked with licensed care providers across the county to identify providers willing to provide this service.
Action Items	 Patrick presented the local prioritization list which had no identified projects (none had been submitted). 911 identified that they intend to apply for a microwave project in Big Sky for around \$17,000 (after the meeting 911 provided \$200,000 as the amount). The AHAD group endorsed this local project with no prioritization. Patrick also presented a statewide project for Situation Analyst Montana that Gallatin County has agreed to host for FFY18. This project is preallocated by the Senior Advisory Committee and does not compete with any local projects. The AHAD group supported this application too.
Updates	 Patrick reported that the Hazard Mitigation Plan grant has been received and an RFP has been drafted and should be released soon. The scope for the project is to update the Hazard Mitigation Plan and incorporate the Community Wildfire Protection Plan into it as one document. The timeframe for the project completion is August of 2019. Patrick updated the group that the RFP for upgraded many of the componenet in the county's mobile command vehicle is on the street. This will replace and upgrade much of the equipment in the vehicle as well as add to our camera capability. The RFP included a couple options for cameras such as remote deployable cameras and tethered drone cameras. The hope is to get the project awarded quickly and hopefully the winning bidder will have build space to complete the work prior to summer. If not we may wait until fall to implement the upgrades.

- The Volunteer Organizations Active in Disaster (VOAD) has resumed meeting and is working to get the group re-invigorated on coordinating with each other. We've discovered that as staff have moved on that previous organizational commitments haven't always been passed on. This presented itself on our Donations Management and Spontaneous Volunteers programs. The VOAD group is currently working on what this looks like today.
- Everyone is encouraged to attend the March 30 tabletop exercise.
 The planning committee is working to make it as illustrative as possible and using a scenario that we haven't used in the county before. It should be a good information exchange for everyone.
 Please make sure that everyone planning to attend registers online so they receive updates and pre-exercise information.
- Patrick reported that Gallatin County received an agreement from Idaho Falls for Urban Search and Rescue Support. It is currently being reviewed by our legal counsel and we expect it to be signed by the County Commission this spring. The agreement is pretty simple; if we call and they can help, then we'll reimburse their costs.
- Emergency Management is working on setting up a one day social media workshop for later this spring. The focus of the workshop is intended to be more advanced fucntions like analytics, paid campaigns, coordinating mulitple contributers, building followership, etc... More to come on the details.
- The Era of Megafires presentation is coming to Bozeman on April 7th.
 This is a good 1.5 hour presentation for anyone about wildfire in the West. It focuses on the current situation, how we got here, and what we'll likley see in the future.
- The back up network linke between the Gallatin County Coordination Center and Butte 911 is completed. The two IT departments are working on completing the configuration and hopefully it will be live shortly.
- We are continuing to utilize the Community Notification System with good sucesss. It was used for localized flooding off Valley Center Rd this week. It has also been incorporated into the Law and Justice Center security planning. The system was activated this weekend for a test with good results.
- Patrick reported that the Coordination Center has been re-configured into pods and the back room is configured into a conference room configuration.
- The State of Montana will be hosting an Advanced Public Information Officer Course in Bozeman this fall. More information to come.
