## Mr. Veitch:

I received the information regarding spill cleanup and disposal as requested in my July 19, 2016 letter. It appears form the information provided that the landowner is satisfied with the cleanup and the diesel-impacted media has been properly disposed. DEQ is satisfied with the remedial actions conducted in response to the June 28, 2016 diesel fuel spill and is closing the spill file.

DEQ does, however, reserve the right to request that further assessment or remedial activities be conducted if information is presented that indicates state waters were impacted as a result of spill. Closure of this spill file may not resolve claims of third parties who may be adversely impacted by this spill.
