RE: Violation of the Montana Solid Waste Management Act [CVID #19114]

Dear Ms. Geavais,

On April 20, 2016, the Enforcement Division (ENFD) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report that approximately 20 gallons of gasoline spilled from a semi-truck fuel tank onto the pavement along Interstate 90, near mile marker 305, Gallatin County, Montana.

On May 27, 2016, an invoice from Best Rate Towing & Repair was received by DEQ ENFD. The invoice does include a line item for Hazmat disposal, but there is no information on where the material was disposed of. There is also no discussion as requested in the May 3, 2016, letter.

In order to return to compliance, ENFD requests the following corrective actions be conducted:

By July 3, 2016, submit a statement certifying impacted media was properly disposed at a permitted solid waste disposal facility. The statement should include a brief discussion on actions implemented to mitigate environmental impacts, cleanup activities, and disposal information.
